DOES YOUR LAWN LOOK LIKE THIS?

As your lawn care service begins, you may notice bare spots in your sod. In order for your lawn to grow and fill in, your sod must first establish a root system. While your yard is being established, you will need to let your grass (and weeds) grow a little longer between cuttings. During this time, your lawn care service company will only be cutting your lawn every 2-3 weeks; however, they will be treating your lawn for weeds.. Please keep in mind that new sod requires a lot of water in order to grow. Please make sure that you are watering your lawn on a regular basis.
